- 1. Look at the Class6Starter spreadsheet; the similarity table indexed by senator-senator pairs shows how alike any two senators are. Kerry and Kennedy are not just similar because they voted the same way; they're also similar in that the Kerry-Snowe similarity is very much like the Kennedy-Snowe similarity, and the same goes for any other senator instead of Olympia Snowe. Of course, if Kerry and Kennedy had identical voting records, this would have to be true, but if their records are merely similar, it doesn't have to be true.
- 2. Look at Russ Feingold. What senator is most like him (in having the greatest agreement-score)? Do that senator and Feingold also have similar agreement-scores will lots of other senators?
